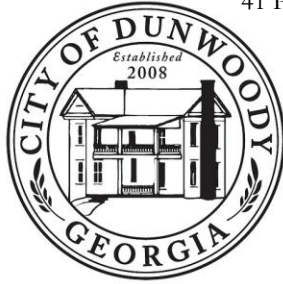

They were as follows:



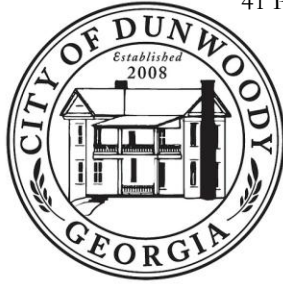

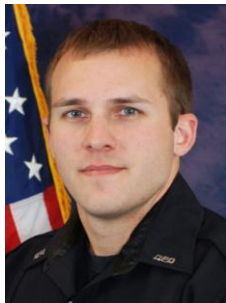
